## MEMBERSHIP

Together in Mission grew out of discussions in 2007 between local Christians and Church leaders about ways we could better serve our communities of Burghfield, Burghfield Common, Sulhamstead, Mortimer, and parts of adjacent parishes.

TiM is a Company Limited by Guarantee and a Registered Charity, which enables us to raise funds and to partner with other organisations to achieve our aims. We work closely with our local clergy and churches, and many volunteers are from their congregations.

### Achievements

The Community Survey undertaken in 2009, leading to:

- Café B, a community café in Burghfield Common
- School Pastors at The Willink School
- TiM Friends, a local befriending service
- TIM CAN, a community information service
- Organising the first Mortimer Fun Day, and supporting it annually
- Initiating the community Christmas trees and carol singing in Burghfield and Mortimer.

## Organisation

The Charity is managed by a small number of Trustees, who are also Directors of the Company. Each community service is managed by a Board with appropriate skills and qualifications and an appointed co-ordinator/manager.

- Identify individual and family needs within local communities and actively find solutions to meet those needs
- Provide opportunities for Christians to serve their community in line with Gospel teaching

\*Extract from the Company Memorandum of Association

*7. Every member promises, if the charity is dissolved while he or she is a member or within 12 months after he or she ceases to be a member, to contribute such sum (not exceeding GBP 10) as may be demanded of him or her towards the payment of the debts and liabilities of the charity incurred before he or she ceases to be a member, and of the costs charges and expenses of winding up, and the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves.*
